



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/06

Specified Statutory Officers - Remuneration and Allowances

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

PART 1 - GENERAL

3. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the determination and revokes and supersedes the previous principal Determination (2002/07) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination.

PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS

4. Clause 2.2 provides Base Salary and Total Remuneration effective on and from 2 May 2003 for the Specified Statutory Offices listed in Table 1. The rates in Determination 2002/07 have been increased by 4 percent following the annual review of remuneration.
5. Other provisions in Part 2 remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/07 (apart from updating some cross-references).

PART 3 – OFFICIAL EXPENSES INCLUDING TRAVEL

8. Part 3 sets out the travelling allowances provisions. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/07.

PART 4 – COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE

11. Part 4 sets out the entitlement for compensation for early loss of office. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/07.
