



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2003/07: Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1

FULL - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 9 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 In accordance with clause 4.2 of the Principal Determination, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that the Managing Director, Special Broadcasting Service, Mr Nigel Milan, shall be paid a performance bonus of \$14,000 for the period 2 February 2002 to 1 February 2003.
- 1.3 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting Table 1 and replacing it with the following table:
