



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/07

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

#### **PART 1 FULL - TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 9 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 specifies that the Managing Director, Special Broadcasting Service, Mr Nigel Milan will receive a performance bonus.
5. Clause 1.3 inserts a new table in the Principal Determination that:
  - a) deletes all references to seventy-six offices that were transferred to Determination Number 23 of 2002 with effect from 19 December 2002; and
  - b) gives effect to the Tribunal's decision to increase the basic rate of salary for the remaining five office holders by 4 percent with effect from 5 April 2003.
6. Clause 1.4 deletes obsolete provisions relating to the offices of Vice-Chief of the Defence Force, the Chief of Navy, the Chief of Army and the Chief of Air Force. These offices have been transferred to Determination 23 of 2002.
7. Clause 1.5 deletes obsolete provisions relating to the offices of Commissioner of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission. The offices have been transferred to Determination 23 of 2002.
