



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2003/09: Remuneration and Allowances for various Holders of Public Office

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to various public office holders, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where specified otherwise.

PART 1 FULL-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 23 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entry of President, Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission and inserting the following:

President, Human Rights and Equal Opportunity Commission	\$127,129	\$182,055	Nil	2.2.9	Tier 1
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- 1.3 Part 2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting a new sub-clause:
"2.2.9 HREOC President: The Base Salary and Total Remuneration as shown in Table 2A only applies to the Hon John von Doussa while he occupies the office of President, HREOC. The normal remuneration for the office is \$182,300 Base Salary and \$260,000 Total Remuneration (as at 19 December 2002). The rates in Table 2A take effect from 10 June 2003 when Mr von Doussa commences in this office".
- 1.4 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the existing entry of Official Secretary to the Governor-General and inserting the following after the reference to the Sex Discrimination Commissioner:

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- 1.5 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the existing entry of the Chairman, Torres Strait Regional Authority and replacing it with the following:

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- 1.6 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the existing entry of the Administrator, Torres Strait Regional Authority and replacing it with the following:

Administrator, Torres Strait Regional Authority	\$112,600	\$167,000	Nil	-	Tier 2
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- 1.7 Clauses 1.2 and 1.3 take effect from 10 June 2003. Clause 1.4 takes effect from 30 April 2003. Clauses 1.5 and 1.6 take effect from 19 December 2002.

PART 2 FULL-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.8 In this part, Determination Number 9 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.9 Part 1, **Table 1** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following footnote (1) for the Managing Director, Special Broadcasting Service:
"Mr Nigel Milan shall receive a personal loading of 15%".
- 1.10 Part 1, **Table 1** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following footnote (2) for the Chief Executive Officer, National Health and Medical Research Council:
"Professor Alan Pettigrew shall receive a personal loading of 7.5% of base salary".
- 1.11 Clauses 1.9 and 1.10 take effect from 5 April 2003.

PART 3 PART-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.12 In this part, Determination Number 3 of 2003 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.13 Part 1, **Table 1** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entry of Deputy Chairperson, Australian Electoral Commission.
- 1.14 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting "Tier 1" in the Travelling Allowance column against the entry of Pharmaceutical Benefits Remuneration Tribunal.
- 1.15 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting "Tier 1" in the Travelling Allowance column against the entry of Anti-Doping Research Panel.
- 1.16 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entry of the Australian Advisory Committee on Road Trauma.
- 1.17 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by changing the name of the National Customs Agents Licensing Advisory Committee to the National Customs Brokers Licensing Advisory Committee.
- 1.18 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by changing the name of the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee to the Corporations and Markets Advisory Committee.
- 1.19 Clauses 1.14 and 1.15 take effect from 5 April 2003.

- 1.18 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by changing the name of the National Customs Agents Licensing Advisory Committee to the National Customs Brokers Licensing Advisory Committee.
- 1.19 Part 2, **Table 2A** of the Principal Determination is amended by changing the name of the Companies and Securities Advisory Committee to the Corporations and Markets Advisory Committee.
- 1.20 Clauses 1.14 and 1.15 take effect from 5 April 2003.

PART 4

SPECIFIED STATUTORY OFFICE HOLDERS

- 1.21 In this part, Determination Number 6 of 2003 is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.22 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting footnote 1 and replacing it with the following:
"The occupants of Specified Statutory Offices as at 20 April 2001 shall receive a base (superannuable) salary equivalent to 72 per cent of the relevant total remuneration figure specified in column 3".
- 1.23 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting clauses 2.9 and 2.10 and replacing them with the following:
"2.9 Where a Specified Statutory Officer accepts and offer of an agency owned or leased vehicle for private use, the Specified Statutory Officer shall have deducted from his or her Total Remuneration, an amount equal to the actual cost (including fringe benefits tax) of the vehicle to the Commonwealth, plus the value of parking, less \$2,975 per annum (in recognition of business use). Should the actual cost to the Commonwealth of a Specified Statutory Officer's vehicle at 6 October 2001 exceed \$21,500 in value, the value of that vehicle will be taken to be \$21,500 until the expiration of the lease arrangement in place on that date.
2.10 Where a Specified Statutory Officer elects not to receive a Commonwealth provided vehicle but instead enters into a salary sacrifice arrangement for the provision of another vehicle, and that vehicle is used for business-related purposes, the Specified Statutory Officer is entitled to an amount of \$2,975 per annum being recognised in the calculation of the salary sacrifice."
- 1.24 Clause 1.22 takes effect from 2 May 2003.
