



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/11

#### Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Full-time Public Office

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for certain Full-time Public Office Holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

#### **PART 1 - GENERAL**

3. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the determination and revokes the previous principal Determination (2002/23) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination.

Other provisions in Part 1 remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23 (apart from the updating of some cross-references).

#### **PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS**

4. Clause 2.1 provides for increased Base Salary and Total Remuneration effective from 1 July 2003 for the Offices listed in Table 2A. The rates in Determination 2002/23 have been increased by 3 percent (rounded) following the annual review of remuneration. As Determination 2002/23 incorporated an increase covering the period until October 2002, this review has encompassed the period since then to 1 July 2003.
5. Other provisions in Part 2 remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23. Several clauses have been deleted as they were obsolete or no longer necessary. Cross-references have been updated.

#### **PART 3 – ALLOWANCES**

8. Part 3 sets out allowance provisions. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23.

#### **PART 4 – OFFICIAL TRAVEL**

11. Part 4 sets out the entitlement for official travel. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23.

## **PART 5 – RECREATION LEAVE**

8. Part 5 sets out the Recreation Leave provisions. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23.

## **PART 6 – COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE**

8. Part 6 sets out the provisions for compensation for early loss of office. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2002/23.
