



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/16

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 – FULL -TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 11 of 1992) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 amends clause 1 of the Principal Determination regarding Compensation for Loss of Office to reflect that part-time office holders are not within the scope of this determination, unless they are performing the duties of a full-time office on a part-time basis (ie. in receipt of a salary calculated on a pro-rata basis to the full-time salary set for the Office).
