



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/18

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. The retrospective application of this determination does not affect the rights of a person (other than the Commonwealth) in a manner prejudicial to that person, nor does it impose any liability on such a person.

PART 1 – PART-TIME OFFICE HOLDERS

3. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 3 of 2003) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
4. Clause 1.2 deletes all references to the now defunct offices of Chairperson and Member of the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority from Part 1, Table 1 of the Principal Determination.
5. Clause 1.3 amends the annual fee for the President, National Competition Council, Dr Wendy Craik, to reflect a decreased number of working days per week.
6. Clause 1.4 replaces Footnote 30 associated with the Australian River Company in Part 2, Table 2 of the Principal Determination with a footnote that reflects an increase in the additional remuneration paid to Mr E G Anson for the period for which he has the approval of the Board to perform executive duties.
7. Clause 1.5 deletes all references in Part 3, Table 3 of the Principal Determination to the following obsolete references to organisations:
 - (a) Australian Dairy Corporation; and
 - (b) Dairy Research and Development Corporation.
8. Clause 1.6 makes a name change from Therapeutic Device Evaluation Committee to Medical Devices Evaluation Committee.
