



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### Determination 2003/19:

### Remuneration and allowances for holders of public offices

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature.

#### **PART 1 COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OF OFFICE**

- 1.1 In this part, Determination Number 11 of 1992 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 1.2 The Principal Determination is amended by deleting sub-clause 1(c) and replacing it with the following:  
'c. the appointment was terminated prematurely for reasons of misbehaviour or unsatisfactory performance; or'

#### **PART 2 PRINCIPAL EXECUTIVE OFFICE**

- 2.1 In this part, Determination Number 15 of 1999 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 Part B of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting sub-clause B5(b) and replacing it with the following:  
'b. the appointment was terminated prematurely for reasons of misbehaviour or unsatisfactory performance; or'

#### **PART 3 JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES**

- 3.1 In this part, Determination Number 21 of 2002 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 3.2 Part B of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting sub-clause B15(c) and replacing it with the following:  
'c. the appointment was terminated prematurely for reasons of misbehaviour or unsatisfactory performance; or'
