



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2003/19

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*. This Determination takes effect from date of signature.

PART 1 – COMPENSATION FOR LOSS OF OFFICE

2. Clause 1.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 11 of 1992) for the purposes of Part 1 of the Determination.
3. Clause 1.2 amends the Principal Determination by adding 'misbehaviour' as an exclusion to the payment of an early termination benefit.

PART 2 – PRINCIPAL EXECUTIVE OFFICE

4. Clause 2.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 15 of 1999) for the purposes of Part 2 of the Determination.
5. Clause 2.2 amends the Principal Determination by adding 'misbehaviour' as an exclusion to the payment of an early termination benefit.

PART 3 – JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

6. Clause 3.1 specifies the Principal Determination (Number 21 of 2002) for the purposes of Part 3 of the Determination.
7. Clause 3.2 amends the Principal Determination by adding 'misbehaviour' as an exclusion to the payment of an early termination benefit.
