



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2004/09

Specified Statutory Officers - Remuneration and Allowances

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

PART 1 - GENERAL

2. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the determination and revokes and supersedes the previous principal Determination (2003/06) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination.

PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS

3. Clause 2.2 provides increased Base Salary and Total Remuneration effective on and from 2 May 2004 for the Specified Statutory Offices listed in Table 1. The rates in Determination 2003/06 have been increased by 3.9 percent following the annual review of remuneration.

Clauses 2.6 and 2.7 have been updated by increasing the amount for business related vehicle usage from \$2,975 to \$3,050 per annum. The rates are based on the motor vehicle allowance in Determination 2004/03.

4. Other provisions in Part 2 remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2003/06.

PART 3 – OFFICIAL TRAVEL

5. Part 3 sets out the official travel provisions. Clause 3.1 specifies that the provisions in Determination 2004/03 apply. Clause 3.2 specifies that Specified Statutory Officers have Tier 1 travel provisions.

PART 4 – COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE

6. Part 4 sets out the entitlement for compensation for early loss of office. Clause 4.1 specifies that the provisions in Determination 1992/11 apply.
