



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### **Explanatory Memorandum: Determination 2004/13 Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Full-time Public Office**

1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for certain Full-time Public Office Holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.

#### **PART 1 - GENERAL**

2. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the determination and revokes and supersedes the previous principal Determination (2003/11) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination.

#### **PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS**

3. Clause 2.1 provides for increased Base Salary and Total Remuneration effective from 1 July 2004 for the Offices listed in Table 2A. The rates in Determination 2003/11 have been increased by 3.9 percent (rounded) following the annual review of remuneration.
4. Other provisions in Part 2 remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2003/11. Several clauses, including in the associated Schedule A, have been deleted as they were obsolete or no longer necessary, Cross-references have been updated.

#### **PART 3 – ALLOWANCES**

5. Part 3 sets out allowance provisions. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2003/11 apart from updating clause 3.1.2 and the associated table for a transitional provision.

#### **PART 4 – OFFICIAL TRAVEL**

6. Part 4 sets out the entitlement for official travel. The provisions of this Part have been updated since the first issue of Determination 2003/11. Travel provisions are now cross referenced to Determination 2004/03.

#### **PART 5 – RECREATION LEAVE**

7. Part 5 sets out the Recreation Leave provisions. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2003/11.

#### **PART 6 – COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE**

8. Part 6 sets out the provisions for compensation for early loss of office. The provisions of this Part remain unchanged from those contained in Determination 2003/11.
