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# Explanatory Statement: Determination 2009/18 Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Full-Time Public Office

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1. The Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into and determined the remuneration and significantly related matters for certain full-time public office holders, as it is empowered to do by the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973*.
2. In making this determination the Tribunal has informed itself through consultation in accordance with established practice.

### **PART 1 - GENERAL**

3. Part 1 specifies the authority for and the date of effect of the Determination and revokes and supersedes the previous principal Determination 2008/08 (as amended) applying to the Offices covered by this Determination. The Part also contains definitions of certain words used in the Determination.

### **PART 2 – REMUNERATION AND RELATED MATTERS**

4. Part 2 provides for an adjustment to Base Salary and Total Remuneration effective from 1 October 2009 for the Offices listed in Table 2A. The rates in Determination 2009/18 have been increased by 3 per cent (rounded) following the annual review of remuneration.

### **PART 3 - ALLOWANCES**

5. Part 3 sets out the allowance provisions. The provisions of this Part remain substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2008/08.

### **PART 4 – OFFICIAL TRAVEL**

6. Part 4 sets out the entitlements for official travel. The provisions of this Part remain substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2008/08.

### **PART 5 – RECREATION LEAVE**

7. Part 5 sets out the recreation leave provisions. The provisions of this Part remain substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2008/08.

### **PART 6– COMPENSATION FOR EARLY LOSS OF OFFICE**

8. Part 6 sets out the provisions for compensation for early loss of office. The provisions of this Part remain substantively unchanged from those contained in Determination 2008/08.
