



REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2015/23: Members of Parliament – Entitlements

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(1), 7(2) and 7(4) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973* (the Act), the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to members of parliament, and matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) Section 7(8AA) of the Act applies to this Determination, so that neither the disallowance provisions in section 7(8) of the Act nor in section 42 of the *Legislative Instruments Act 2003* apply to it.
- (iii) This Determination takes effect on and from Thursday 10 December 2015.

PART 1 - ENTITLEMENTS

1.1 In this part, Determination Number 4 of 2012 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.

1.2 Part 4 of the Principal Determination is amended by replacing Clause 4.16 with the following:

Dependent Children and Designated Persons

4.16 Dependent children and designated persons may use taxis, hire cars or regulated ridesharing services to and from any station or terminal for the purposes of travel at Commonwealth expense under clauses 3.15 and 3.16 provided that if the dependent child or designated person is under the age of 16 they must be accompanied by a person over the age of 18.
