



## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

### **Determination 2004/20: Remuneration and allowances for holders of public offices**

- (i) Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to holders of public office, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where otherwise specified.

#### **PART 1**

#### **JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES**

- 1.1 Principal Determination Number 14 of 2004 (as amended) is further amended by deleting Table 2 and its footnotes and substituting Table 2 and footnotes contained in Attachment A to this determination.
- 1.2 In accordance with Table 2 (footnote 2) of Determination Number 21 of 2002, the Remuneration Tribunal determines that Mr Peter May, Chief Executive Officer, Federal Magistrates Court shall be paid a performance bonus of \$18,529 (15% of base salary) for the period 1 July 2003 to 17 May 2004.

#### **PART 2**

#### **PART-TIME HOLDERS OF PUBLIC OFFICE**

- 2.1 In this part Determination Number 12 of 2004 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- 2.2 **Table A1A of Schedule A** of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting '503' from Column 2 and substituting '30,110', and by omitting 'p/d' from Column 3 and substituting 'p/a', both against the entry for Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research.
- 2.3 **Table A1A of Schedule A** of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting 'Airservices Australia <sup>6 7</sup> #' and substituting 'Airservices Australia <sup>6</sup> #' in Column 1, and by, against this entry, omitting '60,210' from Column 2 and substituting '78,660', and by omitting '25,430' from Column 4 and substituting '39,330'.
- 2.4 **Table A1A of Schedule A** is amended by omitting the text of footnote 6 and substituting:  
'<sup>6</sup> **Airservices Australia:** A member who is appointed as Deputy Chair will receive an additional \$5,454 per annum. While Air Marshal Fisher (retired) remains Deputy Chair, he will be paid a further fee of \$5,000 per annum.'

- 2.5 **Table A1A of Schedule A** of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting an entry for 'The Carrick Institute for Learning and Teaching in Higher Education Ltd' in Column 1 after the entry for the General Practice Recognition Appeal Committee and inserting '666', 'p/d', '503', 'p/d' and 'Tier 1' in Columns 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 respectively.
- 2.6 **Table A1A of Schedule A** is amended by adding an entry at the end named 'Royal Commission into Centenary House Lease<sup>43</sup>' in Column 1, and '1,500', 'p/d', '-', '-', and 'Tier 1' in Columns 2,3,4,5 and 6 respectively.
- 2.7 **Table A1A of Schedule A** is amended by adding a new footnote 43 as follows:  
<sup>43</sup> **'Royal Commission into Centenary House Lease:** Where the Royal Commissioner works less than eight hours on any day, he will be paid \$187.50 per hour for the actual hours worked. Subclauses 2.4 to 2.7 of this Determination do not apply to this office.'
- 2.8 Clauses 2.2, 2.3 and 2.4 take effect from 20 July 2004. Clauses 2.5, 2.6 and 2.7 take effect from 1 July 2004.

(1) A minimum annual payment of ten times the daily fee applies, whether the office holder receives a fee based on daily rates or on hourly rates (under B4).

(2) An additional annual payment of \$13,500 a year applies.

(3) An additional annual payment of \$12,600 a year applies.

(4) In addition to fees specified in Table 2, a part-time member shall be paid a cancellation fee equivalent to 50% of one day's fee for the cancellation of all work on a day with fewer than 5 working days' notice.

(5) An AAT Member appointed prior to 12 August 2004 will continue to receive an additional annual payment of ten times the daily fee whether they receive a fee based on daily rates or on hourly rates (under B4). An AAT Member appointed, or reappointed, after 12 August 2004 shall receive a minimum annual payment of ten times the daily fee whether they receive a fee based on daily rates or on hourly rates (under B4).

(6) A person appointed to this office on a full-time basis before 1 October 1999 shall receive an additional annual payment of \$5,750 a year.
