

REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

Determination 2004/23:

Remuneration and Allowances for Holders of Public Office

- Pursuant to subsections 7(3) and 7(4) of the Remuneration Tribunal Act 1973, the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration and allowances to be paid to various public office holders, and other matters significantly related thereto, and determines as set out below.
- (ii) This Determination takes effect on and from the date of signature except where otherwise specified.

PART 1 - PART TIME OFFICES

- 1.1 In this part Determination Number 12 of 2004 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- Column 1 of Table C1A of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting the name 'Land and Water Resources Research and Development Corporation' and substituting the name 'Land and Water Australia'.
- Table C1A of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting the current wording of footnote 3 and substituting the following entry:
 - ^{'3} A Member of the **Forest and Wood Products Research and Development Corporation**, in addition to his or her annual fee, will receive a per diem fee of \$590, paid in accordance with the provisions of Part 2 of this Determination, when conducting the business of the following bodies: the Market Knowledge and Development Advisory Group; the Hardwood Advisory Group; the Engineered Wood Products Advisory Group; and the Softwood Advisory Group. The Member's normal travel entitlements will also apply to these duties.'
- Clause 1.3 takes effect from 27 October 2004.

PART 2 – FULL TIME OFFICES

- 2.1 In this part Determination Number 13 of 2004 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- Table 3A (Accommodation Allowances) of Part 3 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following entries:

- The Principal Determination is amended by inserting subclause 3.1.6 after subclause 3.1.5, as follows:
 - **'3.1.6 ACCC:** Mr Samuel and Mr Willett are also entitled to accommodation allowances up to the rate specified in Column 3 of Table 3A from 1 July 2003 to 9 December 2004 in respect of Mr Samuel and from 20 January 2003 to 9 December 2004 in respect of Mr Willett.'
- The Table in Clause 3.2 of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following entries:

- The Principal Determination is amended by inserting subclause 3.2.1 after clause 3.2, as follows:
 - **'3.2.1 ACCC:** Mr Samuel and Mr Willett are also entitled to reunion fares up to the rate specified in Column 3 of the Table in clause 3.2, from 1 July 2003 to 9 December 2004 in respect of Mr Samuel and from 20 January 2003 to 9 December 2004 in respect of Mr Willett.'

PART 3 - JUDICIAL AND RELATED OFFICES

- In this part Determination Number 14 of 2004 (as amended) is referred to as the Principal Determination.
- Table 1 (Rates of Remuneration Judicial Offices) of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting \$236,010 in the Full-Time Office Base Salary column and substituting \$259,620 against the entry for the Chief Federal Magistrate in the Federal Magistrates Court.
- Table 1 (Rates of Remuneration Judicial Offices) of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting \$203,970 in the Full-Time Office Base Salary column and substituting \$220,290 against the entry for Federal Magistrate in the Federal Magistrates Court.
- Table 3 (Offices on Total Remuneration) of the Principal Determination is amended by omitting \$145,560 in Column 3 Base Salary and substituting \$160,120, and by omitting \$215,170 in Column 4 Total Remuneration and substituting \$236,690 against the entry for the Chief Executive Officer in the Federal Magistrates Court.
- Table 2 (Rates of Remuneration Non-Judicial Offices) of the Principal Determination is amended by deleting the entries for the National Native Title Tribunal President (non-Judicial) and Registrar, and their associated entries, including footnote (6) and by deleting the rates in the Full-Time Office Base Salary column against the Offices of National Native Title Tribunal Deputy President and Member.
- Table 3 (Offices on Total Remuneration) of the Principal Determination is amended by inserting the following:

- Part E Provisions for Offices on Total Remuneration, of the Principal Determination is amended by adding the following clause E9 after clause E8:
 - 'E9 The National Native Title Tribunal Registrar, Mr Chris Doepel receives a \$5,750 loading per annum in addition to base salary. As the loading is included in superannuation salary, the Total Remuneration of Mr Doepel is increased by \$6,613 per annum in addition to the rate for the office.'
- Under each of the headings for Table 1, Table 2 and Table 3 of the Principal Determination, delete "Effective on and from 1 July 2004" and replace with "Effective on and from 10 December 2004".
