

Remuneration Tribunal

Parliamentary Remuneration and Expenses

STATEMENT

The remuneration and work expenses framework for parliamentarians, established by the *Parliamentary Business Resources Act 2017*, sets out a number of inquiry, reporting and determinative obligations on the Tribunal, to be completed at least once each year.

The Tribunal has decided today¹ to defer any adjustment in remuneration for offices within its jurisdiction, including parliamentary base salary and related matters.

The Tribunal has also completed its inquiries in relation to the remaining remuneration matters (including electorate allowance) and the remuneration and allowances for former parliamentarians set out in its members of Parliament determination, as well as the relevant travel-related matters prescribed in the *Parliamentary Business Resources Regulations 2017*.

The Tribunal has concluded that no changes to the provisions for which it has responsibility will be made at this time. The Tribunal will meet again in **August 2023** to consider further data, and to determine whether any adjustment in remuneration is appropriate for offices in its jurisdiction, including members of Parliament. Any such determination will have effect from **1 July 2023**.

The Tribunal will issues new determinations reflecting this decision.
